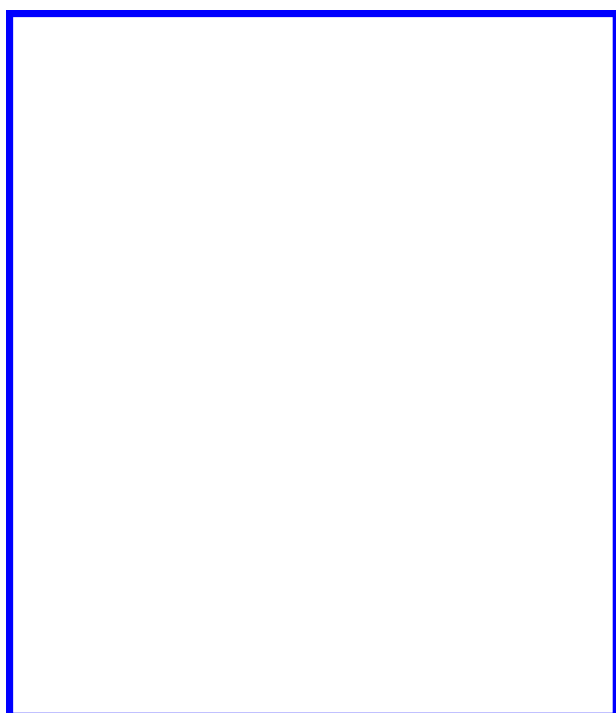

PLANTS FOR REVEGETATION PROGRAM

Last year, the school was given a range of native plant seeds to grow for the 'Pinery Bushfire Revegetation Program'. We prepared the soil and planted the seeds. Since then, Mr Chris Hall (from the Barossa bush gardens) has been visiting to teach us how to properly water and individually separate the seedlings and shown us how to protect them from the sun. With this information we have been carefully examining the plants progression throughout the last 4-6 months and have seen a huge growth in them. With a bit of elbow grease, commitment and patience our 200 seeds have sprouted into healthy saplings that will soon be ready to be planted in the wild.
